

# **Students Changing / Leaving Courses**

## **Rationale:**

This policy documents the school's procedures when students on options courses in Years 10-13 ask to change or leave a subject.

### **Procedures:**

- 1. The student must discuss any proposed change with the Assistant Headteacher (Curriculum) (Years 10-13) and Director of Sixth Form (Years 12/13). These members of staff will consult the teachers of those courses.
- 2. No changes are allowed after 3 weeks in which the course commenced, except in special circumstances (e.g. medical concerns) for which evidence may be required.
- 3. Changes can only be authorised by the Headteacher. Pupils cannot change or leave courses without this authorisation.
- 4. Any agreed changes must be conveyed in writing to parents, Subject Leader of each subject and subject teachers..

### **Evaluation:**

The policy will be reviewed in order to be sure that:

- it is inclusive, and fair for all students
- all staff are clear who should attend their classes.
