Dear Parents / Carers

I have been extremely impressed with Year 12 this year and their dedication to their studies and therefore, I wanted to go through the arrangements for the forthcoming Internal Mock Exams the week commencing on Monday 18th June. Please find attached to this letter a copy of the examination timetable. You will see from the timetable that there are a number of clashes – those who are affected will receive a personal copy of the timetable with clear instructions.

It is imperative we continue to monitor and support their academic progress within the linear structure and therefore, these exams are an important milestone in order to predict UCAS grades and references post-Sixth Form. To that end we will have a **Results Day on Monday 9th July**. The expectation is that students must at least achieve three D grades from these Internal Examinations to progress through to Year 13. If they fail to do so then there will be a Board of Review meeting with the student and parents will be invited in to discuss a plan of action.

With regards to their futures, Year 12 should have set up their work experience for the week commencing 2nd July. If they still require assistance, then I recommend that they contact Mrs Gaulton as soon as possible. This too will help to inform them of what they want to pursue.

Finally, we have Enrichment Week – 9th to 13th July whereby I have arranged for various speakers to come in and talk to Year 12 about their Futures Preparations. We will have various Universities in to discuss Personal statements & UCAS, Student Finance and Life at University. In addition, we will have Apprenticeship schemes along with Medics, Lawyers, the RAF and Independent Careers Advice. A timetable regarding this week will be published in due course.
