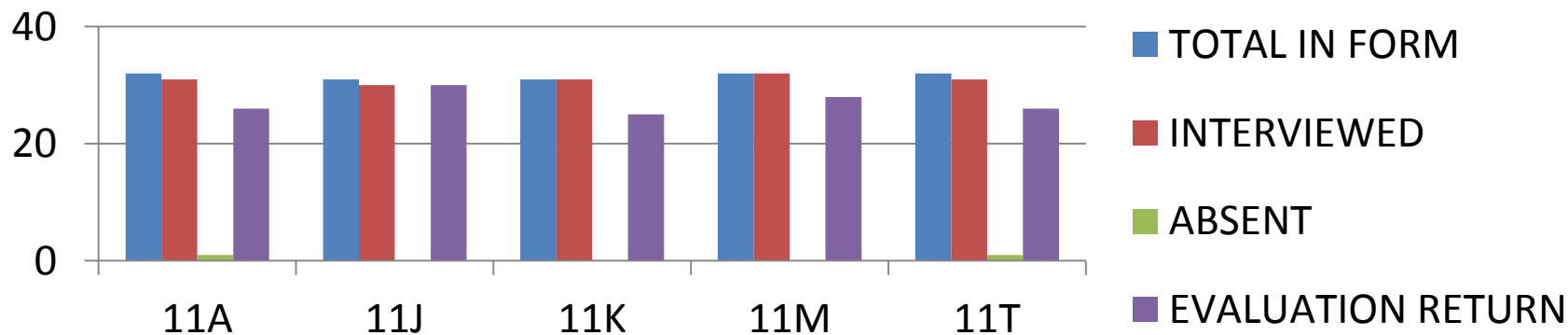


# MOCK INTERVIEW DAY EVALUATION 2016

## 158 IN YEAR GROUP

- 2 PUPILS ABSENT
- 156 PUPILS INTERVIEWED
- 136 EVALUATION FORMS RETURNED 136 (87%)

## PERSONAL TARGETS

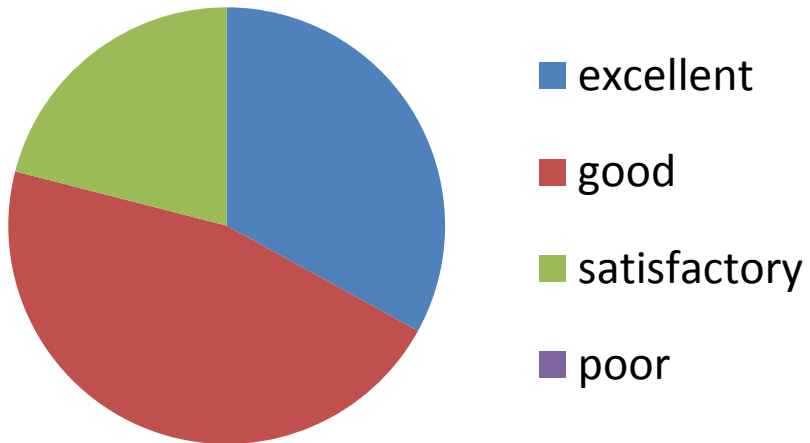
- Project my voice more

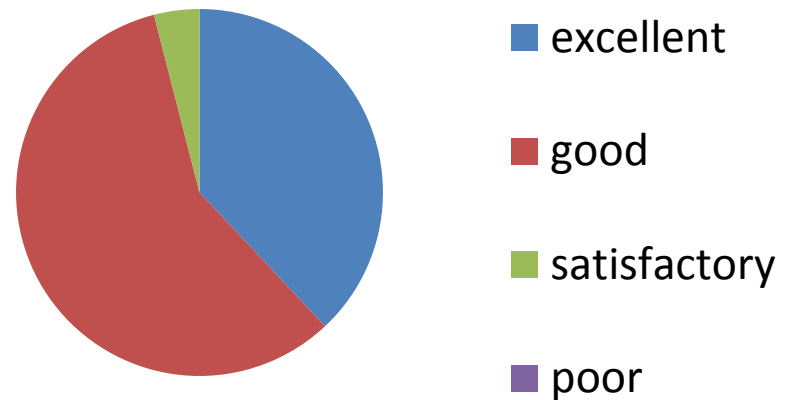
