The table above gives the January data on our year 7 Catch Up students, who scored 95 or less on their year 6 examinations in Maths English or both.

Grades are following the St Mary's Key stage 3 '1 to 9' and Attitude to Learning scores range from -2 to +2. The table therefore shows excellent effort and attainment by these students in English and good effort and attainment in Maths. In both subjects the second half term saw an improvement in students' average effort and in Maths although the average grade is currently lower than in English, the percentage predicted to meet their end of year target has increased by 11% to include all these students, probably as a result of their significantly improved effort.

Maths Catch up students continue to receive additional small group instruction one hour a week as they do in English, where they also take part in the Lexia reading programme. Students are exhibiting such impressive commitment to this that one student has now completed the scheme and 3 students worked really hard over the Christmas holidays and moved up to the next level.
