Summary of table

- Year group with lowest gap in Pupil Premium involvement : Year 7, where far more Pupil Premium students are fully involved than their peers.
- Year group with greatest Pupil Premium involvement gap: year 10 has 11% less involvement on average.
- Year 9 is the year group with the fewest students participating in liturgies, whilst year 10 Pupil Premium is over 50% for this category. No year 9 Pupil Premium students identified themselves as having helped in a liturgy this school year.
- By the end of the year $\frac{3}{4}$ of Pupil Premium student will have bene on an offsite trip, more than a quarter will have had some sort of responsibility and a fifth helped in liturgies.
- There are few Pupil premium gaps in the overall percentages but Pupil Premium students use the library more and participate in assemblies a little less so this is something to encourage for next year.
