Serious Situations

- ❖ Misbehaviour on the coach: *confiscation of bus pass*
- ❖ Incorrect Uniform/Appearance (e.g. hair, ear studs): *inclusion unit*
- ❖ **Exclusions:** vandalism, fighting, aggressive behaviour, smoking, refusal to obey instructions, racism, bullying, theft, persistent disruption, setting off the fire alarm.
- ❖ **Permanent Exclusion:** repeated exclusions, possession of drugs, offensive weapons



Drugs Policy

- ❖ All non-medical drugs on school premises are unacceptable
- ❖ St Mary's will educate its pupils about the dangers of drugs – through PSHEE, Science, assemblies, school nurse, visiting groups , guest speakers
- ❖ A Governor has special responsibility for reporting on the school's work on drug-related issues



Sanctions

- ❖ The possession of legal drugs (alcohol, tobacco) will result in a lengthy exclusion
- ❖ The possession of illegal drugs will result in permanent exclusion, and referral to the Police
- ❖ All schools in this area have agreed this approach
- ❖ No local school wishes to accept a pupil who has been permanently excluded for a drug-related incident
