

## St Mary's Annual Strategic Objectives

2018 - 19

- 1. To develop the spiritual journey of all in our community, particularly through our chaplaincy provision.
- 2. To facilitate the highest quality of learning through dynamic and differentiated teaching.
- 3. To consolidate improved pupil standards (attainment and progress) at KS5, and to maintain our KS4 whole-school standards with no variation visible across the different pupil groups.
- 4. To embed the successful development of Middle Leadership & Management, and to develop the next layer of senior and middle leaders through a secondment programme. To continue to invite and see governors increasingly present in school to exercise their responsibility to monitor and evaluate progress towards our aims and objectives.
- 5. To improve school attendance to 96.5% across all year groups, and to constantly refresh our already effective behaviour for learning strategies.
- 6. To improve our classroom environment in every room with or without building work through a building plan to facilitate 6fe or more, including refurbishment of K Block & PSBP2 (10 new classrooms, canteen & reorientation of the school Reception). To lay the foundations for 2020+ development work in partnership with HCC & the Diocese. To explore new ways for innovative fund-raising.
- 7. To further develop relationships across the community, including closer collaboration and federation with our Lea Valley Deanery Primary Schools; thereby being Academy ready.
- 8. To identify a unique and ambitious 7-yr development plan to deliver 'St. Mary's 2025'
