



Uniform List

Full uniform is compulsory and must be worn at all times. All items of clothing must be marked clearly with pupil's name. Fosters School wear and John Lewis are our uniform stockists. Prices quoted are approximate and subject to alteration without prior notice. Parents are asked to contact the school before buying any item of uniform that they are uncertain about.

Items of uniform marked with an X on the table below are only available from the school uniform supplier. All other items can be purchased from the school supplier, chain stores or sports shops.

Hair may not be dyed, tinted or highlighted. Extreme styles may not be worn. Girls may wear plain, navy ribbons or slides only. Long hair should be tied back for reasons of health and safety.
