### **Leadership Potential**

To qualify to become a Prefect, you will either:

- have demonstrated strong leadership potential and the willingness to take responsibility;
- believe that you have the potential to be a leader and show a willingness to take responsibility.

### **Consistently Positive**

You will also have demonstrated a consistently positive approach to the school and your learning, this means:

- Reliability – Good attendance and punctuality;
- Presentation - Wearing the correct school uniform (Ladies, tailored trousers as opposed to tight fitting trousers or skirts/dresses considerably above knee length). Also, adherence to school expectations of jewellery and make up!
- Good conduct - No recent behaviour issues and consistently showing positive and co-operative conduct;
- Respect - Positively acknowledging the authority of the school at all levels;
- Organisation – Coursework and Homework being completed within the set timescales;
- Ambition/Aspiration – AP/monitoring effort grade and CWG are good or outstanding.

### **Commitment**

In addition to the above, you will be committed to:

- Duties – such as Parents' Evening welcome and serving refreshments;  
- Interview Panels;  
- Liaise and work with Year 10 as the next year group to apply to the Sixth Form;  
- Lower school retreats;
- Support the school during and beyond the normal school hours (e.g. Open evenings, presentation evening, primary liaison work such as Year 5 Experience days and Year 6 Induction Evening and Day and parents' evenings.);
- Assist in assemblies;
- Support the wider community work e.g. Sixth Form Chaplaincy team.
- Help arrange school functions and whole school events such as Charity Week.
